To encourage local involvement there are three categories:

- 1) All schools/colleges within Cirencester
- 2) Individuals/Families who live in Cirencester
- 3) Businesses and Community groups based in Cirencester

For the Fairtrade Poster – please use A4 or A3 portrait.

For the Fairtrade Slogan – please construct a slogan with a maximum of 15 words, including the phrase "...supporting Fairtrade means..."

For Supporting and Promoting Fairtrade please explain in no more than 500 words how you support and promote Fairtrade.

Prizes include Fairtrade hampers and Fairtrade fruit for a week.
